

Clothing that cannot be reused is recycled into new fibers and energy sources. Recently, we have been actively recycling garments into brand new clothing, starting with our down products.













Established in London in 2012 by Japanese garment maker and sewing expert Masahiko Morikawa, Studio Masachuka specialises in the traditional Japanese mending technique known as Sashiko, which dates back to the Edo period (1615-1868). Sashiko was first developed among workers such as farmers and fishermen who used embroidery and stitching to mend worn-out clothing. Back then, cloth was a precious commodity and by applying Sashiko it could be made stronger and last longer. These mended clothes were passed down through generations. In fact, you could say that Sashiko is one of the oldest forms of upcycling.
